This Benched Show - All dogs must arrive Saturday no later than 10:00 A.M. and be benched until 5:00 P.M. All dogs must arrive Sunday no later than 10:00 A.M. and be benched until 4:30 P.M. Every dog that is entered and present must be at its assigned location during benching hours or in the exercise ring, or for a period of one hour prior to the time scheduled for its judging (in Breed/Variety, Group or Best in Show judging) when it is being prepared for showing. Puppies need not be benched until after the judging of the breed classes for which it is entered, but **THEY MUST ENTER THE SHOW GROUNDS BEFORE 10:00 A.M. EACH DAY.** See AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 13, Sections 1, 2, 3 and 4. **FOR DOGS ENTERED ONLY IN OBEDIENCE & RALLY:** One hour after completion of all obedience & rally classes in which a dog is entered, the obedience & rally exhibitor may present themselves with proper legal identification [e.g. Driver's License] at the GGKC Show Office to obtain permission to be excused from the show. All other Benching Regulations apply. Crates and grooming will only be permitted within designated areas. Violators of this notice will be subject to action by the Event Committee.

Unentered Dogs are not allowed at these events. Exhibitors bringing unentered dogs to sell will be subject to Event Committee action. SEE SHOW REGULATIONS FOR FURTHER INFORMATION.

"Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations."

A judge requesting the use of a ramp must give notice to the show superintendent/show secretary prior to judging. AKC approval is not required.

The entire entry in a breed is to be examined in the same manner (ground, table, or ramp).

At the discretion of the judge, the following breeds may be judged on the ground or on a ramp through all levels of competition including Group and Best in Show judging: Lagotti Romagnoli, American Water Spaniels, Clumber Spaniels, English Springer Spaniels, Field Spaniels, Welsh Springer Spaniels, Cimechi dell'Etna, Grand Basset Griffon Vendéens, Standard Schnauzers, American Staffordshire Terriers, Irish Terriers, Kerry Blue Terriers, Soft Coated Wheaten Terriers, Staffordshire Bull Terriers, Finnish Spitz, Keeshonden, Entlebucher Mountain Dogs, Finnish Lapphunds, Icelandic Sheepdogs, Norwegian Buhunds, Polish Lowland Sheepdogs, Spanish Water Dogs and Norrbottenspets (Misc.).

At the discretion of the judge, the following breed may be judged on a table or on a ramp through all levels of competition including Group and Best in Show judging: Mudik (Misc.).

At the discretion of the judge through all levels of competition including Group and Best in Show judging, the following breeds may be judged on the ground, a ramp, or on a table: Boykin Spaniels and Whippets.

The following breeds must be judged on a ramp through all levels of conformation competition: Sussex Spaniels, Basset Hounds, Bulldogs, Chinese Shar-Pei and Chow Chows. This extends to all conformation competition at AKC conformation dog shows and any AKC event where a conformation title may be earned. This policy includes Group, BIS, Junior Showmanship, the 4-6 Month Beginner Puppy Competition, the AKC National Owner-Handled Series (NOHS), and all other special attractions that offer Group and BIS competitions.

Ramps can be used in emergency situations to judge any breed. In an emergency situation, where use of a ramp is not indicated in the premium list, an exhibitor has the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund.

For the judging of juniors the ramp may be used at the discretion of the judge for the ramp optional breeds.

NOTICE

Junior Handlers who win a third Novice Class with competition present or a first place in Novice without competition leading to a Best Junior award with competition would count as one win towards moving to Open, after the closing of entries for a show, **ARE REQUIRED TO TRANSFER** their entry from the Novice Class to the Open Class. **MUST NOTIFY** the Superintendent/Show Secretary prior to the judging of the class at the show.

THERE WILL BE NO ADDITIONAL FEE REQUIRED FOR JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP DOG SUBSTITUTION.

NO PRACTICING ALLOWED IN RINGS AT ANY TIME.

Judges Will Not Wait for Any Dog Holding Up a Class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.

All Dogs Present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

No gasoline or diesel generators are permitted inside any building or within 100 feet of any tent in which this dog show is conducted.

The Club and its Superintendent caution all persons entering the show site and show grounds against all hazards which may exist, including, but not limited to: Condition of the site/grounds, parking/loading/unloading areas, entrances, floors and stairways, elevators and escalators, floor coverings, walkways, tenting/canopies, electrical appliances, cords and fittings, exercise pens, and the presence of animals. All persons should take into consideration this is a sporting event and dress, act and exercise caution appropriate for the activity involved. All persons entering the show, the grounds, site and show areas for whatever purpose do so entirely at their own risk. By virtue of entering the show, the entrant has indicated their acceptance of the terms listed in this premium list and assumes all risks involved.

Important Notices

The State Fire Marshal requires that all bench decorations be treated with a flame retardant product and that the certificate or document that such products have been used be available at the events for review by the State Fire Marshal.

Additionally, the State Fire Marshal reminds all exhibitors that all aisles are to remain free of equipment and must be unobstructed by chests, tables or crates. Only collapsible stanchions and chairs will be allowed within the designated space in front of benching.

Professional handlers (PHA, CPH, DHG, AKC number required) or agents/handlers with MB-F numbers who enter five or more dogs of three or more different breeds/varieties will be benched in a combined Benching/Grooming Area (Philadelphia-style) in Bay C of the Lower Exhibit Hall. (Space will be provided in front of each bench for grooming. **NO Private Exercise Pens or Crates Allowed** in this area. Private exercise pens can be placed along walls across from bench/grooming row. Wire crates only on Benches. No wood, metal, fiberglass solid-sided crates allowed.) Other groups with multiple breed entries will be benched in either the Obedience Section or in the Multi-Breed Benching Areas of the Lower Exhibit Hall.

BENCHING

REMINDER: Only Uncovered Wire Crates are Allowed on the Benches. No Wood, Metal, or Fiberglass Solid-Sided Crates.

SHOW REGULATIONS

1. **Admission Tickets:** One admission ticket will be provided for each dog with one owner and two tickets for each dog with two or more owners for each day the dog is entered.
 2. **It is the responsibility of the exhibitor** to have his dog ready to be shown and at the entrance of the judging ring when the steward calls for the class. Owners of dogs or the handlers of the dogs alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings. This means it is not the responsibility of the ring steward nor of any agent of the show-giving Club to locate any dog, its owner or handler when the dog's presence is needed in a judging ring.
 3. **The Superintendent or Club** will not be responsible for the loss of or damage to any dog exhibited whether the result of accident or other causes. It is distinctly understood that every dog at these events is in the care and custody and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.
 4. **Trophies and prizes** will be awarded in the judging rings to the persons exhibiting the dog, who will be considered to be the owner or agent of the owner. All claims for trophies and other prizes must be made in the judging rings before the completion of the judging of the breed, and the Superintendent's office advised at once in the event of any discrepancy.
 5. **Exhibitors** are admonished to make themselves familiar with the rules of the A.K.C. and with the agreement on the reverse side of the entry blanks that accompany the premium list.
 6. **Entry Fees** shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee. If because of riots, wars, strikes, civil disturbances, national emergencies, health emergencies, and the dictates of law enforcement or of the owner(s) of the grounds and/or facilities or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, heavy rains, or other circumstances including, but not limited to, the condition of the facilities or grounds and/or the ingress and egress from the grounds, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the show before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made.
 7. **Unsightly and objectionable advertising matter** will not be allowed on the benches. The only **ADVERTISING** matter permitted are small signs, no larger than 11 x 14 inches, giving names and addresses of the kennels, the names of dogs, small signs stating that puppies or grown stock are for sale, or a plaque or emblem indicating the exhibitor's membership in recognized specialty clubs.
 8. **Handbills**, circulars or other Printed Material may not be distributed or placed on the benches at these events.
 9. **These are two Bench Shows;** compliance with "Rules Applying to Dog Shows", Chapter 13, Sections 1, 2, 3 & 4 is mandatory. No dogs will be excused prior to 5:00 P.M., Saturday and 4:30 P.M. Sunday. **FOR DOGS ENTERED ONLY IN OBEDIENCE/AND OR RALLY:** One hour after completion of all obedience and/or rally classes in which a dog is entered, the obedience and/or rally exhibitor may present themselves with proper legal identification [e.g. Driver's License] at the GGKC Show Office to obtain permission to be excused from the show. All other Benching Regulations apply. Crates and grooming will only be permitted within designated areas. Violators of this notice will be subject to action by the Event Committee.
 10. **Under no circumstances will exhibitors be allowed to change their bench numbers.**
 11. **All bench decorations must be flame retardant (by order of the State Fire Marshal).**
 12. **No dog shall be on the bench** except in its natural show state. Curlers, rollers or any other artificial aids are not permitted.
 13. **No dog is to be on the bench** in an enclosed crate (e.g. metal, wood, fiberglass). Only uncovered wire crates may be used if necessary.
 14. **No food setups are permitted** in the Cow Palace without permission from the food concessionaire.
 15. **Alcoholic beverages** are not permitted to be brought into the Cow Palace under the state of California Alcoholic Beverage Control Board Law.
 16. **CRATES AND TABLES WILL NOT BE ALLOWED IN THE AISLES OR BENCHING SECTION OF THE SHOW. FURTHERMORE, THE HEIGHT OF BENCH DECORATIONS MAY BE NO MORE THAN 18" ABOVE THE BACK OF THE BENCH. THESE RULES REGARDING CRATES, TABLES, AND HEIGHT OF BENCH DECORATIONS WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.**
 17. **As specified in Chapter 12, Section 4** of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, information contained on the entry form is required to be published in the club's show catalog. This information is also subject to publication in other media.

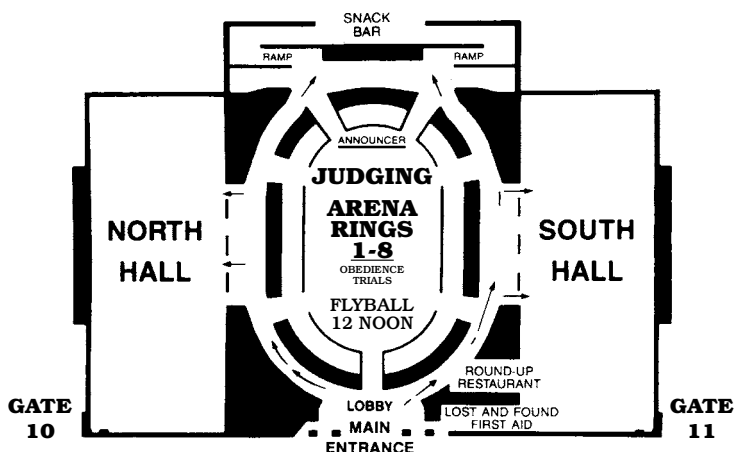

Benching of Dogs

American Kennel Club Rules: Chapter 13, Section 1: At a Benched Show, every dog that is entered and present must be at its assigned location throughout the specified hours for the benching of entered dogs at the show, except for the necessary periods when it is actually being prepared for showing, or is being show, or is in the exercise ring, or is being taken to or from these places. The specified hours shall be the hours listed in the premium list when dogs must be at their benches. **Section 2:** The show-giving club may stipulate, in the premium list, reasonable additional regulations covering benching requirements for their show(s). **Section 3:** Failure to comply with these rules and regulations may cause cancellation of the dog's winnings, and subject the owner, handler, and Superintendent or Show Secretary to a fine and suspension of license and privileges. **Section 4:** Each show-giving club may specify whatever signage and/or decoration that will be allowed at the individual benches. No prizes or ribbons shall be displayed on the bench except those won by the dog at that show. Every dog that is entered and present must be at its assigned location during benching hours or in the exercise ring, or for a period of one hour prior to the time scheduled for its judging (in Breed/Variety, Group or Best In Show judging) when it is being prepared for showing. Puppies need not be benched until after the judging of the breed classes for which it is entered, but THEY MUST ENTER THE SHOW GROUNDS BEFORE 10:00 A.M. EACH DAY.

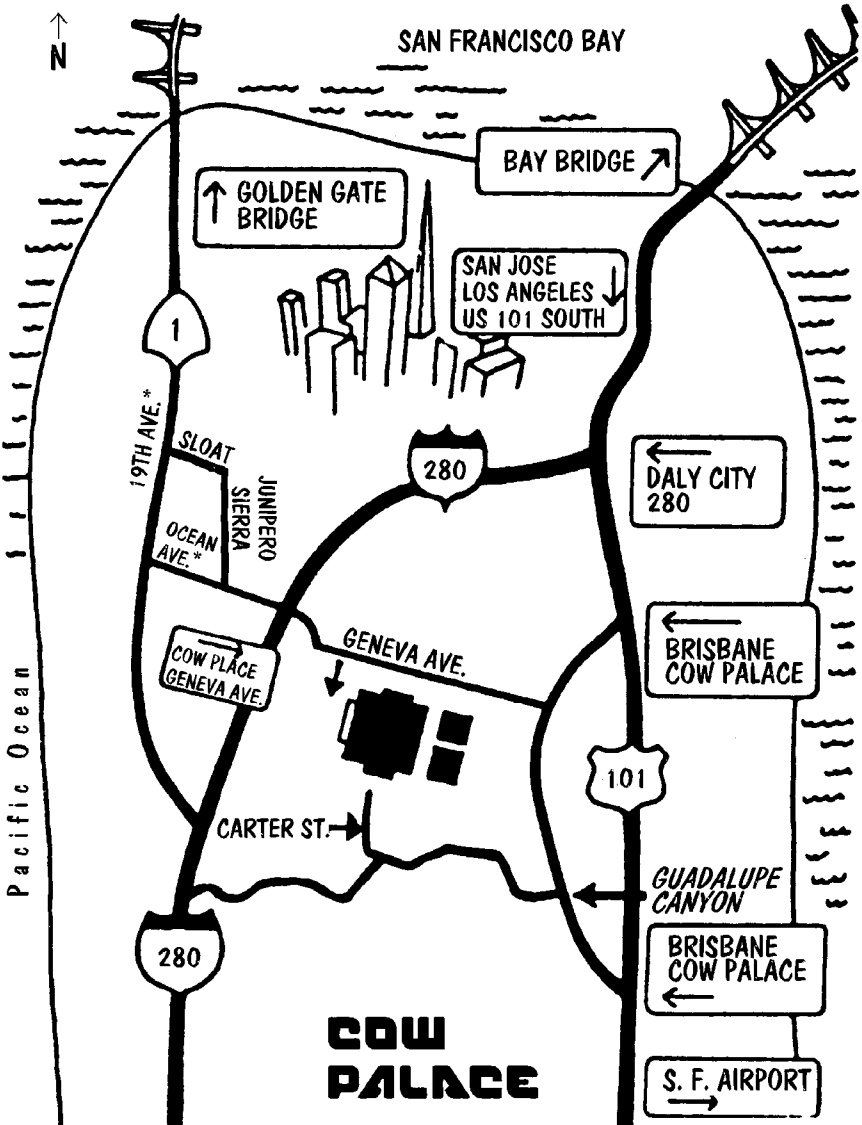
